- 3) Minutes of last meeting – Accepted
- 4) Matters arising:- Database. The missing names from our new database of those who have agreed to receive e-mails was discussed and it was agreed that we should circulate this list so that committee members could approach people that we know are still involved or should receive information.
- 5) Treasurer's report – Current a/c balance £2028.82 (of which Youth a/c £1362.41). Saver a/c £12318.89. Online banking – Jo is in the process of trying to set this up with Nat West. Not as easy as you might think for a society. Agreed that Chairman will have access to monitor activity but not the ability to move any money.
- 6) Next Production – October Pride and Prejudice – Rehearsals start this Sunday 2nd September. Wardrobe has borrowed a large number of costumes from Harlequins. Our thanks go to them and for the ongoing reciprocal agreement to borrow costumes and props but the committee agreed that, in view of the large number this time and the huge saving in cost, we should make a donation of £250 to Harlequins this time by way of thanks. Box office is open and tickets already being sold.
- 7) Future Productions – January “Dr. Doolittle” -Lynn. Jo has DVD which she will pass to Arnold so that he can start looking at the music involved.

Colin suggested giving an award to the best attender for their commitment. This idea will be discussed with the leaders.
